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Foreword

He is a British guitarist, singer, songwriter, and film score composer.

He was originally best-known as the lead guitarist and vocalist for the band ‘Dire Straits’, which he founded in 1977. Since the final Dire Straits album in 1991, Knopfler has continued to record and produce albums as a solo artist, under his own name.

Knopfler has occasionally played in other groups. Additionally, he has performed as a guest on works by other artists, including Bob Dylan, Eric Clapton, Steely Dan and the late Chet Atkins

He is the most widely known performer of reggae music, and is famous for popularising the genre outside Jamaica. Bob Marley was born in Jamaica but he recorded his songs in Chelsea like many musicians did and still do.
